

# Queer and Undocumented Undocubus Riders Welcomed by UU Congregations

This August, Unitarian Universalist congregations offered housing, meals, moral support, and love to a busload of about 30 undocumented immigrants.

About half of the riders were lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or queer.



The "No Papers No Fear Ride for Justice" started July 29 in Phoenix and arrived September 2 in Charlotte. The aim was to "confront power with the stories, voices, and actions of those directly affected by immigration policies."
